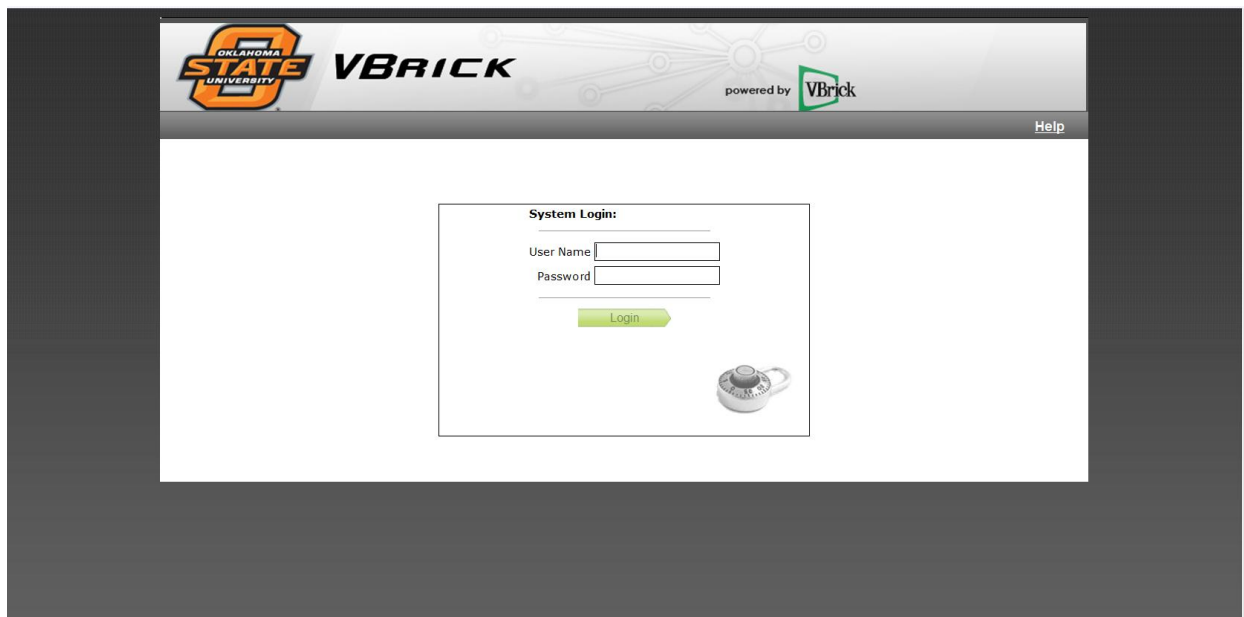


# VBrick Access Procedures

---

VBrick is OSU's powerful capture technology that allows students to access the classroom from any computer that is connected to the Internet. VBrick allows for video to be directly linked from the video camera in the classroom to a VBrick server that captures, encodes, and posts the video to <http://vbrick.okstate.edu>. This is what the VBrick page will look like.

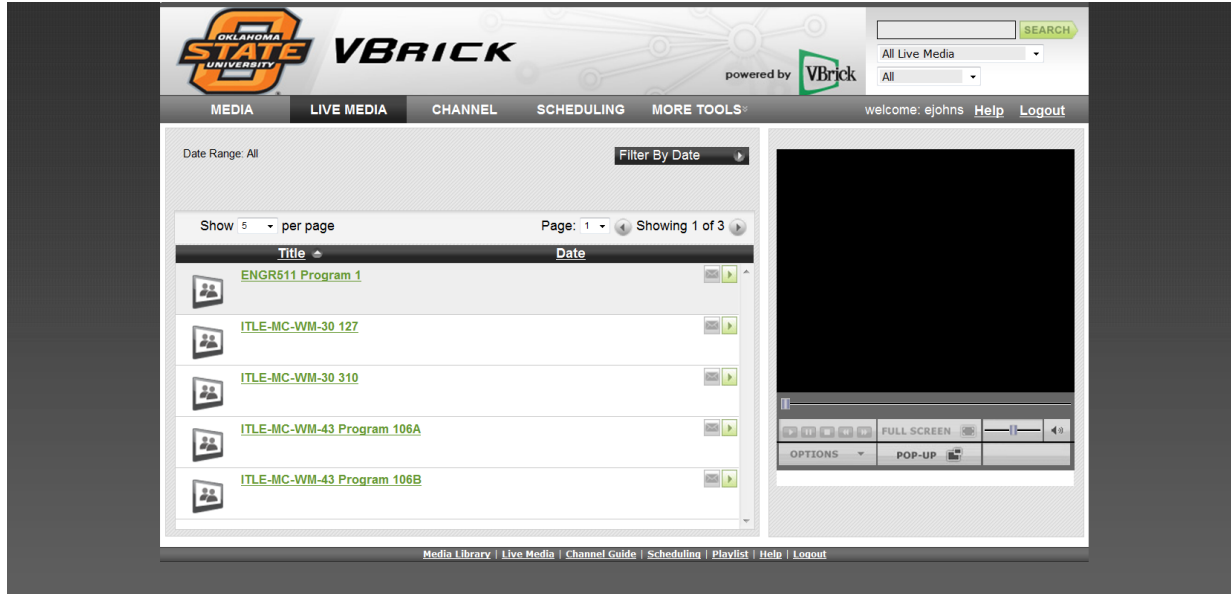
Students and faculty must login using their O-KEY email address and password.

Example:

Username: `jd@okstate.edu`

Password: `xxxxxxx`

Once you are logged in, you will receive a screen like this.
