**Grades.** There will be a quiz most Fridays. You get to drop two quizzes, then the remainder give your quiz average. The quiz average counts as one test. There will be three in-class tests (dates below), and the final will count as two tests, making six "tests" in all. You get to drop the lowest test score, *except* that you can't drop the quiz average. The remaining five scores will be averaged; an average of at least 90 will get an A, at least 80 will get a B, at least 70 will get a C and at least 60 will get a D.

There will be no make-up quizzes or exams given *after* the scheduled date except in case of a documented medical emergency. A *documented* official University event will typically qualify for a makeup exam *before* the scheduled date; in such a case you need to make arrangements with me at least two weeks before the scheduled date.

There will be no calculators (also no iPods, etc.) on quizzes and tests.

**Note** the second test is the day before spring break. That will not count as a valid reason for a makeup test—don't plan on leaving town until after the test.
